The Simplicity of The Gospel
Know It

Romans 3:10

No one is righteous - not even one.

Romans 5:8

God showed his great love for us by sending Christ to die for us while we were still sinners.

Romans 10:9

If you openly declare that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved.

Romans 6:23

The wages of sin is death, but the free gift of God is eternal life through Christ Jesus our Lord.

Acts 10:38-41

You know that God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and with power. Then Jesus went around doing good and healing all who were oppressed by the devil, for God was with him.

And we apostles are witnesses of all he did throughout Judea and in Jerusalem. They put him to death by hanging him on a cross, but God raised him to life on the third day.

Then God allowed him to appear, not to the general public, but to us whom God had chosen in advance to be his witnesses. We were those who ate and drank with him after he rose from the dead.

Acts 10:42-44

And he ordered us to preach everywhere and to testify that Jesus is the one appointed by God to be the judge of all—the living and the dead.

He is the one all the prophets testified about, saying that everyone who believes in him will have their sins forgiven through his name.

Even as Peter was saying these things, the Holy Spirit fell upon all who were listening to the message.



The Power of The Gospel

Trust It

Romans 1:16

I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ, for it is the power of God to salvation for everyone who believes, for the Jew first and also for the Greek.

**I refuse to be ashamed of sharing the wonderful message of God's liberating power unleashed in us through Christ!
[TPT]**

It's news I'm most proud to proclaim, this extraordinary Message of God's powerful plan to rescue everyone who trusts him. [Message]

1 Corinthians 1:18-21

The message of the cross is foolish to those who are headed for destruction! But we who are being saved know it is the very power of God.

As the Scriptures say, “I will destroy the wisdom of the wise and discard the intelligence of the intelligent.”

So where does this leave the philosophers, the scholars, and the world’s brilliant debaters? God has made the wisdom of this world look foolish.

Since God in his wisdom saw to it that the world would never know him through human wisdom, he has used our foolish preaching to save those who believe.

1 Corinthians 1:22-25

**It is foolish to the Jews, who ask for signs from heaven.
And it is foolish to the Greeks, who seek human wisdom.**

**So when we preach that Christ was crucified, the Jews
are offended and the Gentiles say it's all nonsense.**

**But to those called by God to salvation, both Jews and
Gentiles, Christ is the power of God and the wisdom of
God.**

**This foolish plan of God is wiser than the wisest of human
plans, and God's weakness is stronger than the greatest of
human strength.**

Romans 10:13-15, 17

“Everyone who calls on the name of the LORD will be saved.”

But how can they call on him to save them unless they believe in him? And how can they believe in him if they have never heard about him? And how can they hear about him unless someone tells them?

That is why the Scriptures say, “How beautiful are the feet of messengers who bring good news!”

So faith comes from hearing, that is, hearing the Good News about Christ.



Your Gospel Story
Tell It

1 Peter 3:15, Colossians 4:5-6

And if someone asks about your hope as a believer, always be ready to explain it. But do this in a gentle and respectful way. [NLT]

Live wisely among those who are not believers, and make the most of every opportunity. Let your conversation be gracious and attractive so that you will have the right response for everyone

1 Corinthians 9:19-23

When I was with the Jews, I lived like a Jew to bring the Jews to Christ. When I was with those who follow the Jewish law, I too lived under that law. Even though I am not subject to the law, I did this so I could bring to Christ those who are under the law.

When I am with the Gentiles who do not follow the Jewish law, I too live apart from that law so I can bring them to Christ. But I do not ignore the law of God; I obey the law of Christ.

When I am with those who are weak, I share their weakness, for I want to bring the weak to Christ. Yes, I try to find common ground with everyone, doing everything I can to save some. I do everything to spread the Good News and share in its blessings.

Acts 26:9-11

“I used to believe that I ought to do everything I could to oppose the very name of Jesus the Nazarene. Indeed, I did just that in Jerusalem.

Authorized by the leading priests, I caused many believers there to be sent to prison. And I cast my vote against them when they were condemned to death.

Many times I had them punished in the synagogues to get them to curse Jesus. I was so violently opposed to them that I even chased them down in foreign cities.

Acts 26:12-15a

One day I was on such a mission to Damascus, armed with the authority and commission of the leading priests.

About noon, Your Majesty, as I was on the road, a light from heaven brighter than the sun shone down on me and my companions.

We all fell down, and I heard a voice saying to me in Aramaic, ‘Saul, Saul, why are you persecuting me? It is useless for you to fight against my will.’

‘Who are you, lord?’ I asked.

Acts 26:15b-18

And the Lord replied, ‘I am Jesus, the one you are persecuting. Now get to your feet! For I have appeared to you to appoint you as my servant and witness. Tell people that you have seen me, and tell them what I will show you in the future.

And I will rescue you from both your own people and the Gentiles. Yes, I am sending you to the Gentiles to open their eyes, so they may turn from darkness to light and from the power of Satan to God. Then they will receive forgiveness for their sins and be given a place among God’s people, who are set apart by faith in me.’
