Isaiah 9:1-2, 6

If the Good News we preach is hidden behind a veil, it is hidden only from people who are perishing. Satan, who is the god of this world, has blinded the minds of those who don't believe. They are unable to see the glorious light of the Good News. They don't understand this message about the glory of Christ, who is the exact likeness of God.

You see, we don't go around preaching about ourselves. We preach that Jesus Christ is Lord, and we ourselves are your servants for Jesus' sake. For God, who said, "Let there be light in the darkness," has made this light shine in our hearts so we could know the glory of God that is seen in the face of Jesus Christ.

2 Corinthians 3:16-18

But whenever someone turns to the Lord, the veil is taken away.

For the Lord is the Spirit, and wherever the Spirit of the Lord is, there is freedom.

So all of us who have had that veil removed can see and reflect the glory of the Lord. And the Lord—who is the Spirit—makes us more and more like him as we are changed into his glorious image.

Isaiah 60:1-5

ARISE from the depression and prostration in which circumstances have kept you—rise to a new life! Shine (be radiant with the glory of the Lord), for your light has come, and the glory of the Lord has risen upon you!

Darkness as black as night covers all the nations of the earth, but the glory of the LORD rises and appears over you.

All nations will come to your light; mighty kings will come to see your radiance. Look and see, for everyone is coming home!

Your sons are coming from distant lands; your little daughters will be carried home. Your eyes will shine, and your heart will thrill with joy

Job 9:32-33

**He [God] is not a man like me that I might answer him,
that we might confront each other in court.**

**If only there were someone to arbitrate between us, to
lay his hand upon us both, someone to remove God's rod
from me, so that his terror would frighten me no more.**

**Then I would speak up without fear of him, but as it
now stands with me, I cannot.**
