### The God of Creation

John 1:1,14,3

In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.

And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us, and we beheld His glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father, full of grace and truth.

All things were made by him; and without him was not any thing made that was made.

**Colossians 1:15-16, Romans 1:25**

Matthew 8:26-27, 14:31-33

The disciples were amazed. "Who is this man?" they asked. "Even the winds and waves obey him!"

Jesus immediately reached out and grabbed him. "You have so little faith," Jesus said. "Why did you doubt me?"

When they climbed back into the boat, the wind stopped. Then the disciples worshiped him. "You really are the Son of God!" they exclaimed.

John 9:32-33, 35-38

Ever since the world began, no one has been able to open the eyes of someone born blind. If this man were not from God, he couldn't have done it.

When Jesus heard what had happened, he found the man and asked, "Do you believe in the Son of Man?"

The man answered, "Who is he, sir? I want to believe in him."

"You have seen him," Jesus said, "and he is speaking to you!"

"Yes, Lord, I believe!" the man said. And he worshiped Jesus.

## The God of Salvation

Matthew 1:18-21

Now the birth of Jesus Christ was as follows: After His mother Mary was betrothed to Joseph, before they came together, she was found with child of the Holy Spirit.

Then Joseph her husband, being a just man, and not wanting to make her a public example, was minded to put her away secretly.

Some Jewish religious leaders who stood off from the procession said to Jesus, "Teacher, you must order your followers at once to stop saying these things!"

Jesus responded, "Listen to me. If my followers were silenced, the very stones would break forth with praises!"

#### Philippians 2:7-11

He gave up his divine privileges; he took the humble position of a slave and was born as a human being. When he appeared in human form, he humbled himself in obedience to God and died a criminal's death on a cross.
